



What is AdBlue®:

AdBlue is an exhaust-cleaning fluid. It is not a fuel additive but a liquid that mixes with the exhaust gases.

AdBlue is stored in a separate tank, typically identified by a blue cap. It can be located next to the fuel inlet, in the trunk, or under the hood.

All vehicles with diesel engines manufactured after 2011 are equipped with AdBlue tanks. Refueling AdBlue is as essential as refueling with fuel to ensure the proper functioning of the vehicle.
